
The project proposes a wide scope of typological diversity by using in a surational way the constraints of site and flats areas. The 90 meter long plot has not a regular form: its width decreases toward South. On this anomaly we found the quality of the project to transform difficulty into opportunity.

Due to its typological diversity, the building proposes apartments that precisely fulfill the requirements of the brief in terms of areas, and appears as being a world in itself that is an alternative to the strictly individual housing model.

The facade are calm in their design and textured as they are build of load bearing bricks washed in white.






















The rooms of the Andito degli Angiolini in Palazzo Pitti hosted K(C)ongo, Fragments of Interlaced Dialogues., Sammy Baloji's exhibition in Italy.

In the exhibition, enriched by the creation of two new site-specific artworks, motifs and narratives intertwine, drawn from objects that arrived from the Kongo Kingdoms starting in the 16th century, now stored at Palazzo Pitti and in other museums.

In common thread running through the entire exhibition, which covers seven rooms, is an 88 metre-long carpet, wich has been designed and manufactured specifically for the rooms of the exhibition. The decoration stems from the geometric motifs and circular bands of four precious Kongo oliphants.












The multi-storey parking is part of a larger-scale project for a new park for the city of Halle.


The POSSOO project consists of a necessary recalibration of the center of Halle (BE), both in terms of ecology and social amenities. The canvas of the project is the unearthing and renaturalization of the Zenne river, allowing for a new park landscape between the historical core of Halle and the Canal Brussels-Charleroi. Within this green lung, charged with open air sports facilities, a contemporary sports center complements the existing context. The former sports center (1972) with its intriguing wood structure will be reprogrammed as an evolutive parking infrastructure and mixer building. With POSSOO the city of Halle, together with the Flemish Environment Company (VMM), provides a precursing pilot project on the levels of mobility, city center activation, green and blue ecology as well as social empowerment.








Nature as infrastructural support for domestic practices: the contruction of a continuous landscape.


The research inquires into how tourism is able to rewrite a territory, starting from the tourist domestic space, in its possibility of expansion and contraction in a continuous landscape.

The design process is articulated into three simultaneous actions:

- 1. The establishment of a map that aims to visualize the smooth and independent movements of non-resident populations capable of affecting the territory and modifying its edges;
- 2. The construction of a spatial pattern in which infrastructural green can aspire to multiple and heterogeneous configurations. Nature becomes an infrastructural matrix capable of gathering spaces together and a scenario for practices of contemporary living.
- 3. The development of the minimum units of the tourist domestic space which create a continuous landscape in an habitat dictated by natural rhythms.

The overall project is used to interpret some of the contemporary emergencies: climate change, the simultaneous impact of migratory flows and the relationship between man and nature.








Informal buildings, spontaneous landscapes


The survey of this building is at the beginning of a larger project, which will accompany a parallel research about the spontaneous identity of rural landscapes in the mediterranean regions.

The building, measuring 50 square metres, is located on the edge of a larger plot of land, mostly planted with olive trees, with a variety of small fruit trees of indigenous species.

A stone and tufa building, it reflects the typical constructions of small agricultural warehouses that arise to support farming practices. Built in an artisanal manner, the building has structural and performative criticalities that compromise its effectiveness. However, the change of ownership of buildings of this type almost never finds the new users a change of course with regard to construction methods: new stratifications follow one another incessantly without the coordination of any professional figure, considered in most cases as superfluous. Additions of new modules, canopies, concrete platforms, are added to the existing, in disregard of the structural limits and of the overall coherence of the object in itself and with the territory in which it is located.


This project leads the way for a more complex research, which investigates the current and future identity of the rural territory, studded with buildings of this kind, which on the whole characterise and identify the Apulian countryside: wildflowers in wide expanses.















The 50m² building presents a clear stratification that occurred around an original square core. >
